RELATING TO VITAL STATISTICS FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding to part I a new section to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§338- Fees for expedited copies or special services.		
5	A \$50 fee shall be charged for expedited certified copy service		
6	or any services that require special attention for birth, death,		
7	and marriage records that are already registered and accepted by		
8	the department. The department shall keep an account of all		
9	fees collected and shall deposit them to the vital statistics		
10	improvement special fund."		
11	SECTION 2. Section 338-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
12	amended to read as follows:		
13	"§338-14 Fees for certified copies and searches;		
14	transcripts or other statistical summaries of vital records for		
15	National Center for Health Statistics; certified copies for		
16	veterans and others; and corrections on vital statistics		
17	certificates. (a) The department of health shall establish		
18	reasonable fees to be paid for certified copies of certificates:

- 1 provided that the department shall furnish, free of charge, a
- 2 certified copy of any of the records, or a certification of
- 3 birth, to any veteran of the armed forces of the United States,
- 4 the veteran's wife, any member of the immediate family of a
- 5 veteran or the next of kin of a deceased veteran, when required
- 6 for use in connection with a claim based on service in the armed
- 7 forces of the United States. Subject to sections 338-16, 338-
- 8 17, and 338-18, the National Center for Health Statistics may
- 9 obtain transcripts and statistical summaries on computer tapes
- 10 of certificates or, without payment of fees, certified copies;
- 11 provided the State is put to no expense in connection therewith.
- 12 A [reasonable] \$25 fee shall be charged for any correction
- 13 in the items on a vital statistics certificate initiated by the
- 14 registrant or the registrant's parent or representative if the
- 15 registrant is a minor.
- 16 (b) The department [may prescribe reasonable fees] shall
- 17 charge \$10 for searches of files and records not involving the
- 18 issuance of certified copies.
- 19 (c) The department shall keep an account of all fees
- 20 collected and shall deposit them to the [general fund of the
- 21 State] vital statistics improvement special fund, except as

provided in sections 321-1.3, 338-14.5, 338-14.6, 346-7.5, and 601-3.6. 2 3 [Any fee established by the department pursuant to 4 this section shall be adopted in accordance with chapter 91.] In 5 establishing a fee, the amount shall [be sufficient to] cover 6 the expenses involved in [searching for, cost of a copy of, or 7 correction of the certificate, file, or record, as the case may 8 be. The department may raise the fees up to ten per cent per 9 year without being subject to the provisions of chapter 91.] the 10 registration, processing, and issuance of vital records." SECTION 3. Section 338-14.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 **12** amended to read as follows: 13 "§338-14.5 Copies of certificate; fees. The fees for 14 certified copies of birth, marriage, divorce, or death 15 certificates issued by the department of health shall consist of **16** [\$10] \$15 for the first copy issued and [\$4] \$5 for each copy 17 issued thereafter. These fees shall be collected for each 18 single request for certified copies. All fees received for the 19 issuance of certified copies of birth, marriage, divorce, or death certificates shall be remitted to the director of health. 20 21 Upon the receipt of remittances under this section, the director

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VITAL

STATISTICS FEES.

PURPOSE:

To adjust and create fees paid by the public relating to vital records to support vital

statistics operations.

MEANS:

Add a new section to part I of chapter 338 and, amend sections 338-14 and 338-14.5,

Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Department of Health is permitted to charge reasonable fees for certain permitting and licensing functions. Many fees, such as those for certified copies or verifications of vital statistics records, have not kept pace with operating expenses. Other transactions, such for expedited services or corrections to records, are routinely requested and dilute resources but

have no fees attached.

GENERAL FUND:

Increase in amount per fee going to general fund from \$6 to \$10 for certified copies fees.

OTHER FUNDS:

Approximately \$1,650,000 in additional fees annually to the vital statistics improvement special fund.
