## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§286- Driver's license reciprocity committee. (a) The
5	director shall establish a statewide driver's license
6	reciprocity committee consisting of one representative from the
7	department of transportation and each of the four county chief
8	examiners of drivers or their designees. The committee shall
9	convene whenever a foreign country makes a request for driver's
10	license reciprocity.
11	(b) The statewide driver's license reciprocity committee
12	shall evaluate the written knowledge and practical examination
13	program of the requesting foreign country for driver's license
14	reciprocity.
15	(c) Members of the statewide driver's license reciprocity
16	committee shall serve voluntarily and without compensation, but
17	shall be paid reasonable allowances for travel and expenses that
18	may be incurred as a result of the performance of their duties



on the committee. The costs shall be paid by the department of 1 2 transportation. (d) In the event there is available from the requesting 3 foreign country an evaluation prepared by another United States 4 driver licensing agency or the American Association of Motor 5 6 Vehicle Administrators, then the statewide driver's license 7 reciprocity committee shall conduct a comparison review of the 8 evaluation and the State's driver licensing examination 9 standards and submit a written recommendation to the legislature 10 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular 11 legislative session immediately subsequent to the review. **12** (e) If there is no such evaluation available from the requesting foreign country, then the director of transportation 13 14 may select from the statewide driver's license reciprocity committee a representative from the department of transportation 15 and a representative from the counties' examiner of drivers to 16 travel to the requesting foreign country, at the expense of the 17 18 requesting foreign country, to inspect and examine the foreign country's driver's license examination program and advise the 19 committee of their findings. The committee shall review the 20 21 findings and submit a written recommendation to the legislature on whether the foreign country's driver's license examination 22

- 1 standards correspond to Hawaii's driver's license examination
- 2 standards no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 3 the regular legislative session immediately subsequent to the
- 4 travel and evaluation by the driver's license reciprocity
- 5 committee.
- 6 The director of transportation shall adopt rules pursuant
- 7 to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this section."
- 8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
