A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS FIREBOAT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 266-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§266-22 Maintenance of fire boat. The cost of operating
4 and maintaining the fire boat [~~transferred to the city and~~
5 ~~county of Honolulu under Act 175 of the Session Laws of 1951 by~~
6 ~~and through the city and county of Honolulu]~~ shall be borne by
7 the department of transportation. For this purpose, the
8 department shall pay annually from its special fund [~~to the city~~
9 ~~and county of Honolulu the annual cost]~~."


10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Transportation

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HARBORS
FIREBOAT.

PURPOSE: To abolish statutory requirements to
reimburse the City and County of Honolulu
for the operations and maintenance of the
State's fireboat to allow for more
economical management and more comprehensive
response/operational capabilities.

MEANS: Amend Section 266-22, Hawaii Revised
Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Currently the statute requires the
Department of Transportation to reimburse
the City and County of Honolulu for the
operations and maintenance of the State of
Hawaii's Fire Boat. The bill proposes to
allow the Harbors Division to have the
flexibility to enter into a broader
arrangement with the maritime response
community, including the City and County of
Honolulu's Fire Department, to enable
Harbors Division to pursue the most
economical and operationally comprehensive
way to provide Fire Boat services.
