A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$304A-802[+] College-credit equivalency program
- 4 established; purpose; policies and procedures; eligibility. (a)
- 5 There is established at the university and the community
- 6 colleges a college-credit equivalency program. The purpose of
- 7 this program is to award college credits to students who are
- 8 enrolled in a degree or certificate program at the university or
- 9 at a community college and who have successfully completed, at a
- 10 high school, business school, trade school, adult education
- 11 school, or military training program, courses that are
- 12 equivalent to courses offered for credit in the University of
- 13 Hawaii system. The program shall also award credits for
- 14 professional experience gained through service in the United
- 15 States armed forces. Credits may also be awarded for work or
- 16 other experiences at the discretion of the university.
- 17 (b) The university shall be responsible for the
- 18 establishment of policies and procedures to administer the

- 1 program. In this regard, the university, among other things,
- 2 shall prepare and make public the following:
- 3 (1) The list of the high school, business school, trade
- 4 school, and adult education school courses for which
- 5 college credits may be earned;
- 6 (2) The number of credits that may be earned for each
- 7 course; [and]
- 8 (3) The minimum standards or grades necessary to earn
- 9 college credits(-); and
- 10 (4) A learning assessment or other criteria to determine
- 11 college-level learning gained during service in the
- 12 United States armed forces.
- (c) All students enrolled in a degree or certificate
- 14 program at the university or at a community college and who meet
- 15 the requirements established under subsection (b) shall be
- 16 eligible and awarded college-credit equivalents."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
