A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to find ways to
- 2 improve the financial health of the Hawaii employer-union health
- 3 benefits trust fund.
- 4 SECTION 2. (a) The department of budget and finance shall
- 5 conduct a study of the Hawaii employer-union health benefits
- 6 trust fund to improve the financial health of the Hawaii
- 7 employer-union health benefits trust fund. The study shall
- 8 include consideration of:
- 9 (1) The implementation of reforms that moderate the annual
- 10 contributions of public employers for the health
- 11 benefits of active and retired members while
- maintaining sufficient health benefits coverage for
- 13 active and retired members;
- 14 (2) Ways to address the unfunded actuarial accrued
- 15 liability and the implementation of reforms to
- amortize the unfunded actuarial accrued liability of
- the trust fund over thirty years from July 1, 2014;

1	(3)	The cost of providing benefits;
2	(4)	Restructuring the board of directors of the Hawaii
3		employer-union health benefits trust fund to ensure
4		equitable and prompt decisions;
5	(5)	Methods to ensure a reliable and adequate stream of
6		funding for the Hawaii employer-union health benefits
7		trust fund;
8	(6)	The most effective and efficient ways to provide
9	•	healthcare coverage for participants in the Hawaii
10		employer-union health benefits trust fund;
11	(7)	The fundamental alteration of the structure of the
12		Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund;
13	(8)	Assurances of adequate county participation and the
14		determination of any impacts this may have on the
15		counties;
16	(9)	The impacts that enactment of the Patient Protection
17		and Affordable Care Act of 2010 may have on the Hawaii
18	-	employer-union health benefits trust fund; and
19	(10)	Any impacts of anticipated changes in the medicare
20		program on the Hawaii employer-union health benefits
21		trust fund.

- 1 (b) The department of budget and finance may conduct the2 study in-house or contract a third party to conduct the study.
- 3 (c) In conducting the study, the department of budget and
- 4 finance or contractor, as applicable, shall consult with the
- 5 board of trustees, administrator, and staff of the Hawaii
- 6 employer-union health benefits trust fund and the exclusive
- 7 representatives of employees.
- 8 SECTION 3. (a) The department of budget and finance shall
- 9 submit to the governor, legislature, and board of trustees of
- 10 the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund:
- 11 (1) An interim report no later than twenty days prior to
- the convening of the regular session of 2013; and
- (2) A final report that includes findings and
- 14 recommendations on the study no later than twenty days
- prior to the convening of the regular session of 2014.
- 16 (b) The recommendations may include a proposal to
- 17 restructure the board of trustees of the Hawaii employer-union
- 18 health benefits trust fund or change the voting procedure.
- 19 (c) The board of trustees and the administrator and staff
- 20 of the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund shall
- 21 cooperate with the department of budget and finance and its
- 22 contractor, if applicable, in conducting the study.

- 1 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance shall not
- 2 include in the study any recommendation to diminish the health
- 3 benefits or public employers' contributions for employees who
- 4 retired from public service before July 1, 2013.
- 5 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to conduct
- 8 the study required by this Act.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.

Description:

Requires the Department of Budget and Finance to conduct a study to reform the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund. Requires the Department of Budget and Finance to submit to the Governor, Legislature, and Board of Trustees of the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund: (1) An interim report prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2013; and (2) A report, including findings and recommendations, prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014. Appropriates funds for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the study. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2661 HD2)
