A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Pursuant to Act 181, Session Laws of Hawaii
2	2011, the University of Hawaii public policy center, in
3	consultation with the office of planning, submitted a report to
4	the legislature identifying the progress made in implementing
5	the sustainability guidelines and principles, as set forth in
6	Act 181, and making recommendations for legislation or other
7	action to facilitate their full implementation.
8	The purpose of this Act is to implement the recommendations
9	made by the University of Hawaii public policy center in
10	response to Act 181, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011.
11	SECTION 2. (a) The office of planning shall:
12	(1) Convene a working group of government, nonprofit,
13	education, business, and other interested
14	organizations to establish guidelines for the Hawaii
15	statewide sustainability partnership;
16	(2) Determine key indicators for measuring sustainability
17	and establish benchmarks for measuring short-term and
18	long-term progress;

- SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the purposes of this Act.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of this Act.
