### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON OCEAN WATERS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the
2	department of land and natural resources to regulate commercial
3	enterprises that operate out of private marinas and use state
4	waters or marine resources. It is not the intent of this Act to
5	provide for additional regulation of existing regulated commercial
6	enterprises, but to address currently unregulated activities only.
7	SECTION 2. Section 200-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"[+]§200-3[+] Ocean recreation and coastal areas programs.
10	The board shall assume the following functions of the department
11	of transportation:
12	(1) Managing and administering the ocean-based recreation
13	and coastal areas programs of the State;
14	(2) Planning, developing, operating, administering, and
15	maintaining small boat harbors, launching ramps, and
16	other boating facilities and associated aids to
17	navigation throughout the State;

21	launching of recreational or commercial

3	(ii) Other uses of these facilities;
4	(B) Requirements for permits and fees for use of a
5	vessel as a principal place of habitation while
6	moored at a state small boat harbor;
7	(C) Requirements governing:
8	(i) The transfer of any state commercial,
9	mooring, launching, or any other type of use
10	or other permit, directly or indirectly,
11	including, but not limited to, the
12	imposition or assessment of a business
13	transfer fee upon transfer of ownership of
14	vessels operating commercially from, within
15	or in any way related to the state small
16	boat harbors; and
17	(ii) The use of state small boat harbors,
18	launching ramps, or other boating facilities
19	belonging to or controlled by the State,
20	including, but not limited to, the
21	establishment of minimum amounts of annual
22	gross receipts required to renew a

1		commercial use permit, and conditions under
2		which a state commercial, mooring,
3		launching, or any other type of use or other
4		permit may be terminated, canceled, or
5		forfeited; and
6		(D) Any other rule necessary to implement this
7		chapter pertaining to small boat harbors,
8		launching ramps, and other boating facilities
9		belonging to or controlled by the State;
10	(7)	To continue the ocean recreational and coastal areas
11		programs and govern the ocean waters and navigable
12		streams of the State, and beaches encumbered with
13		easements in favor of the public to protect and foster
14		public peace and tranquility and to promote public
15		safety, health, and welfare in or on the ocean waters
16		and navigable streams of the State, and on beaches
17		encumbered with easements in favor of the public $[-$
18		The rules may include: including:
19		(A) Regulating the anchoring and mooring of vessels,
20		houseboats, and other contrivances outside of any
21		harbor or boating facility, including:
22		(i) The designation of offshore mooring areas;
