BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§200- Beaches; operation of motorized vehicles. (a)
5	Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and unless authorized by
6	the board, no person shall drive or operate on any beach in the
7	State any motorized vehicles, except on designated state or
8	county trails and roads that are managed for motorized use;
9	provided that the use of a motorized wheelchair by an individual
10	whose disability requires use of a wheelchair shall not be
11	considered driving or operating a motorized vehicle.
12	(b) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
13	of a petty misdemeanor and shall be fined:
14	(1) \$200 for a first offense;
15	(2) \$400 for a second offense; and
16	(3) \$1,000 for a third or subsequent offense.
17	(c) As used in this section, "motorized vehicle" means a
18	motor vehicle of any type, including automobiles, trucks, vans,

- 1 off-highway vehicles such as all-terrain vehicles, motorcycles,
- 2 motor bikes, mopeds, motor scooters, trail bikes, go-carts, and
- 3 dune buggies, whether the vehicle is licensed or unlicensed."
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
