A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR ADULT EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a public education
- 2 is more than just teaching the rudiments of reading, writing,
- 3 and arithmetic—a public education also prepares students to be
- 4 contributing members of a democratic society. A community with
- 5 members who do not have a well-developed educational foundation
- 6 cannot meet its potential to compete in a competitive,
- 7 international economic environment.
- 8 The legislature further finds that there exists a need to
- 9 provide quality educational programs for those students who fall
- 10 outside of the traditional age range for public school. For
- 11 these adult students, adult educational programs provide a means
- 12 through which they can access basic educational skills, complete
- 13 a high school education, and more actively participate in civic
- 14 life.
- In addition, adult educational programs contribute to the
- 16 overall well-being of Hawaii residents in that they act as a
- 17 connection for adults who would otherwise find themselves
- 18 isolated in an increasingly interconnected society through life



- 1 enhancement courses and, through workforce training, provide
- 2 continued access to the job market for those who may find
- 3 themselves unemployed.
- 4 The purpose of this Act, therefore, is to appropriate
- 5 general funds to maintain adult educational programs for
- 6 Hawaii's residents.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,500,000 or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to
- 10 maintain adult educational programs.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
