- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- "§710- Disrespect of a house of the legislature. (1) 4
- A person who is not a member of either house of the legislature 5
- commits the offense of disrespect of a house of the legislature 6
- if, while the person is present at a legislative session of 7
- either house or at a hearing of any committee of either house, 8
- 9 the person creates a breach of peace or disturbance with intent
- to interrupt the proceeding. 10
- 11 (2) Whenever there is probable cause to believe that a
- 12 person has violated subsection (1), the person shall be subject
- 13 to arrest and removal from the presence of the legislature or
- 14 either house or any committee of a house, by the sergeant-at-
- arms of the affected house or by any other law enforcement 15
- officer of the State, as directed by the sergeant-at-arms. 16
- 17 (3) Disrespect of a house of the legislature is a petty
- 18 misdemeanor."
