A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIFORM INTERSTATE DEPOSITIONS AND DISCOVERY ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by

 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read

 set as follows:

 "CHAPTER

 UNIFORM INTERSTATE DEPOSITIONS AND DISCOVERY ACT
- 7 Uniform Interstate Depositions and Discovery Act.
- 8 § -2 Definitions. In this chapter:
- 9 "Foreign jurisdiction" means a state other than this State.

Short title. This chapter may be cited as the

- 10 "Foreign subpoena" means a subpoena issued under authority
- 11 of a court of record of a foreign jurisdiction.
- 12 "Person" means an individual, corporation, business trust,
- 13 estate, trust, partnership, limited liability company,
- 14 association, joint venture, public corporation, government or
- 15 governmental subdivision, agency or instrumentality, or any
- 16 other legal or commercial entity.

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1	"State	" means a state of the United States, the District of
2	Columbia, Pu	uerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, a

5	"Subpoena" means a document, however denominated, issued	
6	under authority of a court of record requiring a person to:

9	de	esignated books, documents, records, electronically
10	st	cored information, or tangible things in the
11	po	ossession, custody, or control of the person; or
12	(3) Pe	ermit inspection of premises under the control of the
13	ре	erson.
14	§ -3	Issuance of subpoena. (a) To request issuance of
15	a subpoena u	under this section, a party shall submit a foreign
16	subpoena to	a clerk of court in the circuit in which discovery
17	is sought to	be conducted in this State. A request for the
18	issuance of a subpoena under this chapter does not constitute as	
19	appearance i	in the courts of this State.
20	(b) Wh	nen a party submits a foreign subpoena to a clerk of

court in this State, the clerk, in accordance with that court's

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- 1 procedure, shall promptly issue a subpoena for service upon the
- 2 person to which the foreign subpoena is directed.
- 3 (c) A subpoena under subsection (b) shall:
- 4 (1) Incorporate the terms used in the foreign subpoena;
- 5 and
- 6 (2) Contain or be accompanied by the names, addresses, and
- 7 telephone numbers of all counsel of record in the
- 8 proceeding to which the subpoena relates and of any
- 9 party not represented by counsel.
- 10 § -4 Service of subpoena. A subpoena issued by a clerk
- 11 of court under section -3 shall be served in compliance with
- 12 rule 45(c) of the Hawaii rules of civil procedure.
- 13 § -5 Deposition, production, and inspection. Rules 26,
- 14 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 34(c), and 45 of the Hawaii rules of civil
- 15 procedure shall apply to subpoenas issued under section -3.
- 16 § -6 Application to court. A motion to the court for a
- 17 protective order or to enforce, quash, or modify a subpoena
- 18 issued by a clerk of court under section -3 shall comply with
- 19 the rules of court and statutes of this State and be submitted
- 20 to the court in the circuit in which discovery is to be
- 21 conducted.

- 1 § -7 Application to pending actions. This chapter
- 2 applies to requests for discovery in cases pending on the
- 3 effective date of this chapter."

4 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
