BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-504, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$304A-504 Hawaii state scholars program. (a) There is
- 4 established the Hawaii state scholars program to be administered
- 5 by the University of Hawaii. This program shall be used to
- 6 provide financial assistance in the form of scholarships for up
- 7 to four years to any qualified student enrolled at any campus of
- 8 the University of Hawaii with the possibility of renewal for a
- 9 fifth year in exceptional circumstances.
- 10 (b) Appropriations for the state scholars program shall be
- 11 deposited into the University of Hawaii scholarship and
- 12 assistance special fund established pursuant to section
- 13 304A-2159. The number of scholarships awarded and amount of
- 14 each scholarship shall be determined by the university subject
- 15 to the availability of funds.
- 16 The University of Hawaii shall offer scholarships to pay
- 17 for educational costs, such as tuition, fees, books, housing,
