### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BROADBAND.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§201- Broadband special fund. (a) There is		
5	established in the state treasury the broadband special fund		
6	into which shall be deposited:		
7	(1) Moneys deposited pursuant to Act , Session Laws of		
8	Hawaii 2012;		
9	(2) Appropriations from the legislature;		
10	(3) All accrued interest from the fund; and		
11	(4) Contributions, grants, endowments, or gifts in cash		
12	received by the fund.		
13	(b) Moneys in the broadband special fund shall be expended		
14	by the department of business, economic development, and tourism		
15	for the purpose of supporting an initiative to provide:		
16	(1) Broadband access to public schools; and		
17	(2) The means necessary for technology-based learning in		
18	public schools, including but not limited to the

1	provision of laptop computers to public school
2	students.
3	(c) The broadband special fund may receive contributions,
4	grants, endowments, or gifts in cash or otherwise from all
5	sources including corporations or other businesses, foundations
6	government, individuals, and other interested parties.
7	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, as a
8	condition of a gift to the broadband special fund, a donor may
9	specify a particular county in which the donor's gift shall be
10	used or expended for the purposes listed in subsection (b).
11	(d) The State may appropriate moneys to the special fund,
12	provided that any appropriations made by the State are not
13	intended to supplant the funding of any existing public school
14	program.
15	(e) All unexpended and unencumbered moneys remaining on
16	balance with the broadband special fund on June 30, 2017, shall
17	lapse to the credit of the state general fund."
18	SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
19	beginning January 1, 2013, and in each year thereafter, all
20	recipients of moneys appropriated from fees collected pursuant
21	to chapter 440G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall receive no more
22	in annual appropriations than the lesser of:

Broadband; Cable Television Systems; Special Fund

#### Description:

Creates broadband special fund to support funding public school broadband and laptop initiatives. Beginning 01/01/13, freezes appropriations of moneys derived from cable fees at the lesser of the 2011 appropriation or the amount that a recipient would otherwise receive in the current year. Requires excess moneys to be deposited into the broadband special fund. Effective 07/01/12 and repealed 06/30/17.
