A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1		PART I
2	SECT	ION 1. (a) Not later than January 1, 2013, the
3	departmen	t of education, in consultation with the department of
4	business,	economic development, and tourism, the department of
5	agricultu	re, and members of the agricultural community, shall
6	establish	and administer an agricultural education pilot program
7	for publi-	c school students on the island of Molokai, the island
8	of Lanai,	and the east district of the island of Maui. The
9	pilot program shall:	
10	(1)	Provide students with hands-on experience in
11		cultivating agricultural products;
12	(2)	Educate students on the principles of
13		entrepreneurship;
14	(3)	Sell the agricultural products cultivated by students
15		in the pilot program to consumers, including consumers
16		at farmers' markets and restaurants; and
17	(4)	Offer academic credit to students who participate in
18		the pilot program.

- 1 (b) Revenues generated by the pilot project for the sale
- 2 of agricultural products shall be deposited into the
- 3 agricultural education pilot program special fund pursuant to
- 4 section 2 of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) There is established in the state treasury
- 6 the agricultural education pilot program special fund to be
- 7 administered by the department of education.
- 8 (b) The following shall be deposited into the special
- 9 fund:
- 10 (1) Legislative appropriations to the special fund;
- 11 (2) Revenues generated by the agricultural education pilot
- 12 program pursuant to this Act;
- 13 (3) All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in
- the special fund; and
- 15 (4) Any other moneys made available to the special fund.
- (c) Moneys in the special fund shall be expended for
- 17 expenses incurred by the department of education in establishing
- 18 and administering the agricultural education pilot program.
- 19 SECTION 3. The department of education shall submit a
- 20 report to the legislature regarding the agricultural education
- 21 pilot program and make findings and recommendations, including
- 22 whether to continue the pilot program, not later than twenty



- 1 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2017. The
- 2 report shall include any pertinent information, recommendations,
- 3 or proposed legislation, if any, to determine whether the
- 4 agricultural education pilot program should be extended to other
- 5 areas throughout the State.
- 6 PART II
- 7 SECTION 4. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 9 and to read as follows:
- 10 "\$235- Agricultural education tax credit. (a) There
- 11 shall be allowed for each qualified agricultural business
- 12 subject to the tax imposed by this chapter an income tax credit
- 13 for qualified agricultural education activities. The credit
- 14 shall be deductible from the taxpayer's net income tax
- 15 liability, if any, imposed by this chapter for the taxable year
- 16 in which the credit is properly claimed. The tax credit amount
- 17 shall be per cent of the qualified agricultural costs
- 18 incurred by the taxpayer after December 31, 2012.
- 19 (b) If the credit under this section exceeds the
- 20 taxpayer's net income tax liability for the taxable year, the
- 21 excess of the credit over liability shall be refunded to the
- 22 taxpayer; provided that no refunds or payments on account of the



1	credits a	llowed by this section shall be made for amounts less
2	than \$1.	
3	<u>All</u>	claims for a tax credit under this section, including
4	amended c	laims, shall be filed on or before the end of the
5	twelfth m	onth following the close of the taxable year for which
6	the credi	t is claimed. Failure to comply with the foregoing
7	provision	shall constitute a waiver of the right to claim the
8	credit.	
9	<u>(c)</u>	The director of taxation:
10	(1)	Shall prepare any forms that may be necessary to claim
11		a credit under this section;
12	(2)	May require the taxpayer to furnish information to
13		ascertain the validity of the claim for credit made
14		under this section; and
15	(3)	May adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to effectuate
16		this section.
17	<u>(d)</u>	The department of agriculture shall:
18	(1)	Maintain records of the total amount of qualified
19		agricultural education costs for each taxpayer
20		claiming a credit;
21	(2)	Verify the amount of the qualified agricultural
22		education costs claimed;

1	(3)	Total all qualified agricultural education costs	
2		claimed; and	
3	(4)	Certify the total amount of the tax credit for each	
4		taxable year.	
5	<u>Upon</u>	each determination, the department of agriculture	
6	shall iss	ue a certificate to the taxpayer verifying the	
7	qualifyin	g agricultural education costs and the credit amount	
8	certified	for each taxable year.	
9	The	taxpayer shall file the certificate with the taxpayer's	
10	tax return with the department of taxation. Notwithstanding th		
11	departmen	t of agriculture's certification authority under this	
12	section,	the director of taxation may audit and adjust	
13	certifica	tion to conform to the facts.	
14	(e)	As used in this section:	
15	"Qua	lified agricultural business" means any person with a	
16	commercia	l agricultural or aquacultural facility or operation	
17	who allow	s the department of education to use the facility or	
18	operation	for the agricultural education pilot program	
19	establish	ed by Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2012.	
20	"Qua	lified agricultural education costs" means	
21	expenditu	res, costs, or losses that are attributable to the
