## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§356D- Prohibition on smoking in and around public		
5	housing; designated smoking areas. (a) Smoking shall be		
6	prohibited in any public housing project, as defined in section		
7	356D-1, or state low-income housing project, as defined in		
8	section 356D-51, within:		
9	(1) Each individual housing unit;		
10	(2) Hallways;		
11	(3) Enclosed or partially enclosed common areas; and		
12	(4) Twenty feet from each individual building of the		
13	public housing project or state low-income housing		
14	project.		
15	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the authority shall		
16	designate one or more permissible smoking areas not less than		
17	twenty feet from any residential building or community facility		

- 1 within the public housing project or state low-income housing 2 project. 3 (c) For purposes of this section: 4 "Common areas" means those portions of the land, building, 5 and all appurtenances and easements that are available for use 6 by tenants or as designated by the authority as a common area. "Smoking" means inhaling or exhaling the fumes of tobacco 7 8 or any other plant material, or burning or carrying any smoking 9 paraphernalia for tobacco or any other plant material that is 10 lit." 11 SECTION 2. Section 356D-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 13 "(a) Except as otherwise provided, the authority may terminate any lease, rental agreement, permit, or license 14 15 covering the use and occupation of any dwelling unit or other 16 premises located within a public housing project and evict from 17 any premises any tenant, licensee, or other occupant for any of 18 the following reasons:
- 19 (1) Failure to pay rent when due;
- (2) Violation of any of the provisions of a lease, rental
   agreement, permit, or license;
- 22 (3) Violation of any of the rules of the authority;

Public Housing; Low-income Housing; Smoking Prohibition

Prohibits smoking in and around public housing projects or state low-income housing projects under the jurisdiction of the Hawaii public housing authority, with an exception for designated smoking areas. Allows for eviction upon a third violation of the smoking prohibition. (SD2)
