A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ACCESS TO REAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 508D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§508D- Public access; residential and agricultural real
5	property. (a) In addition to any other requirement under this
6	chapter, the seller or seller's agent shall disclose in writing
7	to the buyer the existence, if any, of:
8	(1) Any access, including an easement or court-ordered
9	access; and
10	(2) Any traditional public access of which the seller has
11	actual knowledge,
12	that burdens or may burden the real property being sold;
13	provided that the disclosure shall be prepared in good faith and
14	with due care pursuant to section 508D-9.
15	(b) This section shall apply to the sale of residential or
16	agricultural real property.
17	(c) This section shall not apply to the following types of

- 4 statement made by a seller in compliance with chapter 508D,
- 5 Hawaii Revised Statutes, prior to its effective date.

- 8 begun, before its effective date.

- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Legal or Traditional Public Access; Written Disclosure

Description:

Requires a seller to disclose in writing to a buyer the existence, if any, of legal or traditional public access that burdens the residential or agricultural real property being sold, and that the disclosure be prepared in good faith and with due care. Effective July 1, 3000. (HB518 HD2)
