HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TWENTY-FOUR HOUR OPEN-AIR CULTURAL MARKETPLACES THROUGHOUT HAWAII.

WHEREAS, in a time of economic distress for our State, the Legislature supports ways to help keep critical dollars within the State, strengthen the State's communities, and provide a boost to local business, which in turn will help the state and local governments by providing increased revenue streams; and

WHEREAS, showcasing Hawaii's diverse culture to visitors will provide economic stimulus and the prospect of future growth to the State's visitor industry; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of twenty-four hour open-air cultural marketplaces across Hawaii will provide visitors with opportunities to have a truly local experience, unique to the islands, enabling them to shop for locally grown and made items from Hawaii's entrepreneurs, artisans, and farmers; taste
