RECOGNIZING THE 2012 HONPA HONGWANJI MISSION OF HAWAII'S LIVING TREASURES.

WHEREAS, a key force in the Hawaiian renaissance, Lynette Kahekili Paglinawan perpetuates Hawaiian culture and music and works to draw peace from conflict by practicing ho'oponopono; and

WHEREAS, a benevolent educator and extraordinary 'ukulele player, Gordon Mark set his mark by fusing Western classical and Hawaiian music and working tirelessly to compile a repertoire of more than 1,000 songs; now, therefore,
