## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, article 10E, Hawaii Revised
- 2 Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "PART . HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE CLAIMS HISTORY.
- 5 §431:10E- Purpose. The purpose of this part is to
- 6 regulate the use of claims history information for homeowners
- 7 insurance and provide certain consumer protections with respect
- 8 to the use of this information.
- 9 §431:10E- Scope; effective dates. This part shall apply
- 10 to all homeowners insurance policies delivered or issued for
- 11 delivery in this State after July 31, 2012.
- 12 §431:10E- Definitions. As used in this part:
- 13 "Inquiry" means a telephone call or other communication
- 14 made to an insurer regarding the terms, conditions, or coverage
- 15 afforded under an insurance contract that does not result in a
- 16 claim, including questions concerning whether a policy will
- 17 cover a loss or the process for filing a claim. The term shall

- 1 not constitute a claim for purposes of section
- **2** 431:13-103(a)(11).
- 3 §431:10E- Use of inquiries and other information. An
- 4 insurer shall not refuse to issue, refuse to renew, or cancel a
- 5 homeowners insurance contract, or establish rates for coverage
- 6 based in whole or in part on inquiries made by any consumer to
- 7 an insurer, unless the inquiry provides information not
- 8 previously disclosed by the insured."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
