BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§5-6 Seal; commercial use. (a) Whoever uses any
- 4 representation of the great seal or the coat of arms of the
- 5 State in any advertisement or for any commercial purpose or in
- 6 any manner likely to give the impression of official State
- 7 approval shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. The preceding
- 8 sentence shall not be construed to apply to the use of the seal
- 9 or the coat of arms in any newspaper, periodical, book or
- 10 pamphlet wherein the seal or coat of arms is printed for
- 11 informational purposes only.
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), any elected official
- of the State may use a representation of the great seal or the
- 14 coat of arms of the State on any item intended as a gift for a
- 15 dignitary. For the purposes of this subsection, "dignitary"
- 16 includes an elected or appointed official of any country,
- 17 territory, state, county, or locality."
- 18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
