BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 291-54, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$291-54 Display of removable and temporary removable 4 windshield placards. The placard shall be displayed in such a 5 manner that it may be viewed from the front [and rear] of the 6 vehicle by hanging it from the front windshield rearview mirror 7 [of a vehicle] or by displaying it on the front dashboard of the 8 vehicle when the placard is in use. [If the design of the 9 rearview mirror precludes hanging the placard in a secure 10 manner, the placard shall be displayed on the dashboard.] " 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
