RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:		
3	"(b) An invitation for bids shall be issued, and shall		
4	include a purchase description and all contractual terms and		
5	conditions applicable to the procurement. If the invitation for		
6	bids is for construction, it shall specify that all bids include		
7	the name of each person or firm to be engaged by the bidder as a		
8	joint contractor or subcontractor in the performance of the		
9	contract and the nature and scope of the work to be performed by		
10	each[-], provided that the bidder shall have up to two days		
11	following the closing date for submission of bids to submit:		
12	(1) The required information; and		
13	(2) Any corrections or amendments to a list of joint		
14	contractors or subcontractors that was previously		
15	submitted; provided that any corrections or amendments		
16	are limited to:

1	(A)	The inclusion of additional joint contractors or	
2		subcontractors; provided that the total bid	
3		amount is unchanged; and	
4	<u>(B)</u>	The removal of joint contractors or	
5		subcontractors that are not licensed to perform	
6		work within the nature or scope of the proposed	
7		bid.	
8	Bids shall be opened pursuant to subsection (d) following the		
9	close of the two-day period. Construction bids that do not		
10	comply with [this requirement] these requirements may be		
11	accepted if acceptance is in the best interest of the State and		
12	the value of t	he work to be performed by the joint contractor or	
13	subcontractor is equal to or less than one per cent of the tota		
14	bid amount."		
15	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
16	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
17	begun before i	ts effective date.	
18	SECTION 3	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
19	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.	

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
