BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter to title 25 to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: 4 "CHAPTER 5 PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGERS 6 -1 Definitions. For the purposes of this chapter, 7 unless the context otherwise requires: "Department" means the department of commerce and consumer 8 affairs. 10 "Director" means the director of commerce and consumer 11 affairs. 12 "Pharmacy benefit manager" means any third party manager of 13 a prescription drug program employed by or under contract with a 14 pharmacy operating pursuant to chapter 461. 15 -2 Registration. (a) No pharmacy benefit manager 16 shall operate in the State without registering annually with the **17** department.

2	the department of any registration-related changes within ten

4	§ -3 Registration fee. The department shall assess an
5	initial registration fee and a subsequent annual registration
6	fee to be determined by the director and adjusted from time to
7	time, which shall be deposited into the compliance resolution
8	fund in accordance with section 26-9(0).
9	§ -4 Rules. The director may adopt rules, pursuant to
10	chapter 91, as the director deems necessary for the effective
11	administration and enforcement of this chapter.
12	§ -5 Penalties. Any person violating this chapter or
13	the rules adopted pursuant to this chapter, shall be fined not
14	more than \$500."
15	SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
