A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that health insurance
- 2 exchanges established in the Patient and Protection Affordable
- 3 Care Act of 2010 are intended to support consumers and their
- 4 access to quality affordable health care as well as information
- 5 that will help consumers to make informed decisions regarding
- 6 health care.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to clearly define the consumer
- 8 in the health insurance exchange board, strengthen statewide
- 9 consumer and business representation on the health insurance
- 10 exchange board, address conflicts of interest on the health
- 11 insurance exchange board by preventing health plans from serving
- 12 on the board, and requiring the health insurance exchange to
- 13 offer a basic health plan.
