A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the supplemental
- 2 nutrition assistance program, formerly known as the food stamp
- 3 program, is a federal and state program to help low-income
- 4 families buy the food they need to stay healthy and be
- 5 productive members of society. In 2010, the federal government
- 6 increased funding to the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 7 program and changed the rules to allow more families to qualify.
- 8 Because unemployment checks caused many recipients' gross income
- 9 to exceed the one hundred thirty per cent of the income poverty
- 10 threshold, the federal government increased the gross income
- 11 limit to two hundred per cent. The department of human services
- 12 struggled to manage the increased caseload that ensued.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 14 department of human services to address the increased caseload
- 15 that followed the United States Department of Agriculture's
- 16 mandate to amend supplemental nutrition assistance program
- 17 income eligibility requirements, which increased the number of
- 18 potential beneficiaries of the program.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for
- 4 the department of human services to sufficiently respond to and
- 5 carry out the requirements of the United States Department of
- 6 Agriculture's mandate to amend the supplemental nutrition
- 7 assistance program eligibility requirement from no more than one
- 8 hundred thirty per cent of the income poverty guidelines
- 9 prescribed by the United States Department of Health and Human
- 10 Services to no more than two hundred per cent of the income
- 11 poverty guidelines.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
