A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE POLLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 342F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:

 "\$342F- Bird noise; restrictions. (a) In any urban
- 5 land use district, as designated pursuant to section 205-2, it
- 6 shall be unlawful for any person to harbor, breed, keep, or
- 7 raise birds within a residential zone or within one hundred feet
- 8 of a residential zone in the State, if the birds produce
- 9 excessive noise that unreasonably interferes with the
- 10 comfortable enjoyment of life and property at any time of day in
- 11 those affected areas.
- (b) Violators shall be fined \$50 for the first violation,
- 13 \$100 for the second violation, \$200 for the third violation, and
- 14 \$500 for each subsequent violation.
- (c) Any county may adopt a rule or ordinance that places
- 16 stricter limitations on bird noise than this section. In case
- 17 of a conflict between the requirements or limitations of this

- 1 section and any county rule or ordinance regarding bird noise,
- 2 the more restrictive requirements shall apply.
- 3 (d) For the purposes of this section, "bird" means any
- 4 aves or class of warm-blooded vertebrates distinguished by
- having the body more or less completely covered with feathers 5
- 6 and the forelimbs modified as wings."
- 7 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 8
