- 7 intentionally makes a report or causes the transmission of a
- 8 report to law-enforcement, child welfare services, or judicial
- 9 authorities relating to a crime or other incident within their
- 10 concern when the person knows that the information contained in
- 11 the report is false.
- 12 (2) False reporting to law-enforcement, child welfare
- 13 services, or judicial authorities is a misdemeanor."
- 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
