BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Public assistance programs limit eligibility to 1 2 those who have few or no assets. Unfortunately, such asset limits provide an incentive for individuals to divest themselves 3 of assets and a disincentive to accumulate assets. 4 problematic, as families need assets to avoid and escape poverty 5 6 and become self-sufficient. 7 The Corporation for Enterprise Development is a national nonprofit based in Washington, D.C., dedicated to expanding 8 economic opportunity for low-income families and communities. 9 10 The Corporation for Enterprise Development recommends that states, among other things, completely eliminate asset limits 11 12 for their temporary assistance for needy families programs or raise the asset limit for those programs to \$15,000. As of 13 today, one state has raised its asset limit to \$15,000, and five 14 states have completely eliminated their asset limits. 15 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 16
