A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Public assistance programs limit eligibility to
- 2 those who have few or no assets. Unfortunately, such asset
- 3 limits provide an incentive for individuals to divest themselves
- 4 of assets and a disincentive to accumulate assets. This is
- 5 problematic, as families need assets to avoid and escape poverty
- 6 and become self-sufficient.
- 7 The Corporation for Enterprise Development is a national
- 8 nonprofit based in Washington, D.C., dedicated to expanding
- 9 economic opportunity for low-income families and communities.
- 10 The Corporation for Enterprise Development recommends that
- 11 states, among other things, completely eliminate asset limits
- 12 for their temporary assistance for needy families programs or
- 13 raise the asset limit for those programs to \$15,000. As of
- 14 today, one state has raised its asset limit to \$15,000, and five
- 15 states have completely eliminated their asset limits.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 17 human services to conduct a study to evaluate current asset
- 18 limits for public assistance programs, including the temporary SB2178 SD2 LRB 12-1897.doc



- 1 assistance for needy families program, and assess the effects of
- 2 changing the asset limits on those programs.
- 3 SECTION 2. The department of human services shall conduct
- 4 a study on asset limits for public assistance programs, which
- 5 shall include:
- 6 (1) An evaluation of current asset limits;
- 7 (2) Information on promising activities, policies, and
- 8 trends; and
- 9 (3) The potential effects of changing the asset limits on
- 10 the supplemental nutritional assistance program,
- 11 temporary assistance for needy families program,
- 12 temporary assistance for other needy families program,
- and Med-QUEST program.
- 14 The department shall report its findings and
- 15 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 16 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 17 the regular session of 2013.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
