14		assisting others to engage in sexual conduct[-]; or
15	<u>(e)</u>	Possesses thirty or more images of any form of child
16		pornography, and the content of at least one image
17		contains one or more of the following:
18		(i) A minor who is younger than the age of twelve;

- 1 (ii) Sadomasochistic abuse of a minor; or
- 2 (iii) Bestiality involving a minor."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.

Description:

Amends the offense of promoting child abuse in the second degree to include possession of thirty or more images of child pornography if at least one image contains a minor younger than the age of twelve, sadomasochistic abuse of a minor, or bestiality involving a minor. Effective January 7, 2059. (SB2221 HD1)
