RELATING TO COURT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 607-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d)	Sheriff's or police officer's fees:
4	(1)	For serving any criminal summons, warrant, attachment,
5		or other criminal process, [\$30 effective July 1,
6		2001.] <u>\$50;</u>
7	(2)	For serving any civil summons, warrant, attachment, or
8		other civil process, [\$25 effective July 1, 2001.]

10	(3)	For every copy of an attachment and inventory of the

3	In lieu of any fee under this subsection, the fee may be an			
4	hourly rate of not less than $[\$50]$ $\$75$ per hour agreed upon in			
5	advance between the party requesting the service and the sheriff

7	SECTION 2. Section 607-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
8	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:			
9	"(a) For all necessary travel in making the service, per			
10	mile for every mile more than [one40] one, 60 cents provided			
11	that:			
12	(1) No allowance shall be made where the serving officer			
13	uses a conveyance furnished the serving officer by the			
14	State, or any political or municipal subdivision			
15	thereof;			
16	(2) Where the serving officer serves more than one person			
17	in the course of one trip, the serving officer shall			
18	not charge, in the aggregate for all services more			
19	than the mileage for the entire trip; and			
20	(3) As far as practicable, in order to minimize the			
21	mileage fees for the service, the sheriff or other			
22	chief of the serving officers, where service of			

1	process is to be made upon an island other than that
2	upon which is situated the court issuing the process,
3	shall cause the process to be transmitted to a deputy,
4	the chief of police, or other serving officer upon the

13	For serving civil summons or any other civil process,
14	except a subpoena or a garnishee summons, for each person served
15	therewith [\$25 effective July 1, 2001.], \$40.
16	For serving: subpoena, for each person, $[\$25;]$ $\$40;$ and
17	subpoena duces tecum or garnishee summons, for each person [\$15
18	effective July 1, 2001.], \$35.
19	For returning as unserved after due and diligent search any
20	process when it has been found that the person to be served has
21	left the State [\$5 effective July 1, 2001.], \$10.

- 1 For serving any execution or other process for the 2 collection of money, for every dollar collected up to \$1,000 3 [5], 9 cents. 4 And for every dollar over \$1,000 $\left[\frac{2-1/2}{2}\right]$, 5 cents. 5 All fees paid to any printer for publishing an 6 advertisement of the sale of any property. 7 For every bill of sale [\$2.], \$4.8 For executing and acknowledging a deed pursuant to a 9 sale of real estate to be paid by the grantee in the deed 10 [\$8.], \$10. 11 For drawing any bond required by law [\$2.], \$4. 12 For serving writ of possession or restitution, 13 putting any person entitled into the possession of 14 premises, and removing a tenant pursuant to order of court 15 [\$25.], \$40. 16 Together with all necessary expenses incurred by the **17** officer serving the writ, incident to the eviction. 18 For selling any property on an order from the court other 19 than an execution, the same allowance as for service and sales 20 by execution. 21 The fees for service of executions, attachments, and 22 collection of judgments, together with all costs incurred after

- 1 judgment rendered, not included in the judgment, in all courts
- of the State, shall be collected in addition to the sum directed 2
- to be levied and collected in the writ. 3
- 4 In lieu of any fee under this subsection, the fee may be an
- 5 hourly rate of not less than [\$50] \$75 per hour agreed upon in
- 6 advance between the party requesting the service and the sheriff
- 7 or police officer performing the service."
