RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§237- Exemption for rental income; transitional shelter
5	for homeless persons. (a) There shall be exempted from, and
6	excluded from the measure of, the taxes imposed by this chapter,
7	all of the gross proceeds arising from the leasing of real
8	property, whether by lease or sublease on the whole or a portion
9	of the property, received by an owner or lessor, as applicable,

11	(1) Nonprofit organizations registered under section
12	501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code;
13	(2) State, county, or federal agencies; or
14	(3) Provider agencies contracted by the department of
15	human services pursuant to section 346-365;
16	provided that the real property is used to provide transitional

- 3 (b) For purposes of this section:
- 4 "Homeless" shall have the same meaning as in section

- 6 "Real property" shall have the same meaning as in section
- 7 356D-1, and includes the whole real property or a portion
- 8 thereof.
- 9 "Transitional shelter for homeless persons" means real
- 10 property that is used to provide up to twenty-four months of
- 11 temporary shelter to homeless families or individuals."

- 13 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
- 14 gross income or gross proceeds received after June 30, 2012.
