8	within two hours after learning about the child's

10	(B) Report the location of the child's corpse to a law	
11	enforcement agency within two hours after learning the	
12	location of the corpse;	
13	provided that the child's death appears to have occurred under	
14	any of the circumstances described in section 841-3.	
15	(2) Failure to report the death of a child or the location	
16	of a child's corpse is a class B felony."	
17	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
18	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
19	begun before its effective date.

### Report Title:

Failure to report a missing child; Failure to report the death of a child or the location of a child's corpse

Imposes a duty on parents and guardians to report a missing child within 48 hours. Imposes a duty on parents and guardians to report the death of a child or the location of a child's corpse within 2 hours of discovery. Makes the failure to report a missing child, child's death, or location of a child's corpse a felony.
