BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 371, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

5	hotline; posting requirement; penalty. (a) An establishment,
6	as defined in this section, shall post in a conspicuous place
7	near the entrance to, or other area where posters and notices
8	are customarily posted on the premises of the establishment, a
9	poster of no smaller than eight and one-half inches by eleven
10	inches in size that states the following:
11	"If you or someone you know is being forced to engage in
12	activity - such as commercial sex, housework, farm work, or
13	any other similar activity - and cannot leave, call the
14	National Human Trafficking Resource Center Hotline at 1-
15	888-373-7888 to access help and services.
16	Victims of human trafficking are protected under U.S. and
17	Hawaii law.
