A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that state agencies are 2 interested in using energy savings performance contracting to 3 improve the energy efficiency of their facilities, thereby 4 addressing deferred maintenance and achieving a reduction in a 5 facility's life cycle operating costs. Energy savings performance contracting is an agreement between an agency and a 6 7 company by which the company, without any initial agency funds, , 8 will design, finance, implement, and maintain changes to an agency facility to increase energy efficiency. The company 9 quarantees that savings will be achieved due to the changes and 10 11 the agency agrees to pay the company a part of the resulting 12 savings. Thus, wasted energy and operating costs are turned 13 into capital improvements. 14 Requests for proposals can take eighteen to sixty months to 15 complete. In contrast, the negotiated partner approach, by 16 which an agency may negotiate directly with certain vendors to 17 execute a performance contract exempt from the state procurement

code, can bring about energy savings improvements in twelve to

- 1 eighteen months. The legislature also finds that a negotiated
- 2 partner pilot program is an appropriate means of determining the
- 3 ability of the negotiated partner approach to allow agencies to
- 4 take full advantage of energy savings performance contracts.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to establish a two-year pilot
- 6 program using the negotiated partner approach to execute energy
- 7 savings performance contracts.
- 8 SECTION 2. (a) There shall be established within the
- 9 department of accounting and general services a pilot program
- 10 using the negotiated partner approach to execute energy savings
- 11 performance contracts. The pilot program shall allow any state
- 12 agency to negotiate directly with a vendor on the list of
- 13 qualified vendors for a sole-source energy savings performance
- 14 contract for one building or structure under the agency's
- 15 jurisdiction, notwithstanding chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised
- 16 Statutes.
- 17 (b) By December 31, 2012, the department shall compile a
- 18 list of qualified vendors eligible to participate in the pilot
- 19 program under this Act through the issuance of a request for
- 20 qualifications.
- 21 (c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary relating to
- 22 the award of public contracts, an energy savings performance

contract	under the pilot program shall be awarded in accordance
with the	following provisions:
(1)	The contract shall be signed by June 30, 2013, with
	the construction of improvements completed by June 30,
	2014;
(2)	The term of the contract shall not exceed twenty years
	from the date of completion of the construction of
	improvements;
(3)	The contract shall provide that the agency receive
	title to the energy system being financed under the
	contract upon substantial completion of the project,
	as agreed to by the agency and lender; and
(4)	The contract shall provide that total payments to the
	vendor shall not exceed total savings achieved and may
	provide that annual payments to the vendor shall not
	exceed annual savings achieved.
SECT	ION 3. Any agency that participates in the pilot
program e	stablished by this Act shall report to the department
of accoun	ting and general services annually from 2013 to 2019 or

- 1 include probable reasons for the results. The department shall
- 2 establish the deadline for the annual report.
- 3 SECTION 4. The department of accounting and general
- 4 services shall submit to the legislature an annual report on the
- 5 results of the energy savings performance contracts formed under
- 6 this Act, including information on which agencies are
- 7 participating in the pilot program and which facilities are
- 8 affected, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 9 each regular session from 2014 to 2020.
- 10 SECTION 5. Nothing in this Act shall prevent or preclude
- 11 an agency from soliciting or executing an energy savings
- 12 performance contract outside of the pilot program pursuant to
- 13 chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Establishes the negotiated partner approach pilot program for energy savings contracts, which allows agencies to forego requests for proposals and negotiate directly with qualified vendors. Requires reports to DAGS and the legislature. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD1)
