A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds and declares that
- 2 safeguarding the environment, public health, safety, and general
- 3 welfare through the establishment of building and construction
- 4 requirements related to sustainability is necessary.
- 5 Sustainable building and construction requirements reduce the
- 6 negative potential impacts and increase the positive potential
- 7 impacts of the built environment on the natural environment and
- 8 building occupants.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to require the state building
- 10 code to include code provisions based on the latest edition of
- 11 the International Green Construction Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 107-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- "[+]\$107-25[+] State building code; requirements. There
- 15 is established a state building code applicable to all
- 16 construction in the State of Hawaii. The state building code
- 17 shall include:
