BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1. Chapter 487R, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	"§487R- Unlawful use of certificate of identification of	
5	driver's lic	ense. (a) No person shall scan the machine-
6	readable zon	e of an individual's certificate of identification
7	or driver's	license to use or retain any information contained
8	therein, exc	ept for the following purposes:
9	<u>(1)</u> <u>To</u>	verify the age of the individual who possesses the
10	<u>ce</u>	rtificate of identification or driver's license;
11	<u>(2)</u> <u>To</u>	verify the authenticity of the certificate of
12	<u>id</u>	entification or driver's license;
13	<u>(3)</u> <u>To</u>	record, retain, or transmit information as required
14	by	law;
15	<u>(4)</u> <u>To</u>	transmit information to a check service company for
16	th	e purpose of approving negotiable instruments,
17	el	ectronic funds transfers, or similar methods of
18	pa	yments; provided that only the name and

1	identification number from the certificate of		
2	identification or driver's license may be used or		
3	retained by the check service company; or		
4	(5) To collect or disclose personal information that is		
5	required to report, investigate, or prevent fraud,		
6	abuse, or material misrepresentation.		
7	(b) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty		
8	of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of no more than \$2,000,		
9	or imprisonment of no more than one year, or both; provided that		
10	each violation of this section shall constitute a separate		
11	offense.		
12	(c) As used in this section, "certificate of		
13	identification" means the certificate of identification		
14	described under part II of chapter 846."		
15	SECTION 2. Chapter 487R, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
16	amended by amending the title to read as follows:		
17	"DESTRUCTION AND UNLAWFUL USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION		
18	RECORDS"		
19	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
