16	Under this license, no liquor shall be consumed on the

1 (1) Beer; 2 (2) Wine; 3 (3) Alcohol; and 4 (4) Other specified liquor. 5 It shall be unlawful for any holder of a manufacturer 6 license to have any interest whatsoever in the license or 7 licensed premises of any other licensee. This subsection shall 8 not prevent the holder of a manufacturer license under this 9 chapter or under the law of another jurisdiction from 10 maintaining any interest in the license or licensed premises of 11 a wholesale dealer licensee under this chapter." 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
