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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§487J- Identity theft prevention policy and procedure;		
5	requirements; penalty. (a) By January 1, 2014, every business		
6	that maintains personal information shall implement a		
7	comprehensive, written policy and procedure to prevent identity		
8	theft. The policy and procedure shall include administrative,		
9	technical, and physical safeguards for the protection of		
10	personal information. In addition, the policy and procedure		
11	shall be designed to:		
12	(1) Ensure the security and confidentiality of personal		
13	information and medical, educational, and financial		
14	records;		
15	(2) Protect against any anticipated threats or hazards to		
16	the security or integrity of personal information and		
17	medical, educational, and financial records; and		

Prevent the occurrence of any security breach.

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- 1 (b) Every business covered by this section shall train all 2 employees in the implementation of the policy and procedure to prevent identity theft. Employees shall be required to sign a 3 form acknowledging receipt of training, and the business shall 4 deposit each employee's acknowledgment in the employee's file. 5 (c) Notwithstanding section 487J-3 to the contrary, any 6 business that violates this section shall be fined not more than 7 8 \$100 for each violation. The penalty provided in this section 9 shall be cumulative to the remedies or penalties available under 10 all other laws of this State." SECTION 2. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 12 amended by amending the title to read as follows: 13 "CHAPTER 487J [SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER] PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION" 14 SECTION 3. Section 487J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 16 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows: 17 ""Identity theft" has the same meaning as in section 489P-18 19 2. 20 "Security breach" has the same meaning as in section 487N-21 1."
