A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERSONAL INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TON 1. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§487J- Unlawful use of Hawaii identification card or		
5	driver's	license. (a) No business may scan the machine-	
6	readable	zone of an individual's Hawaii certificate of	
7	identific	ation or driver's license, except for the following	
8	purposes:		
9	<u>(1)</u>	To verify the identity of the individual who possesses	
10		the Hawaii certificate of identification or driver's	
11		license if the individual pays for goods or services	
12		with a method other than cash, returns an item, or	
13		requests a refund;	
14	(2)	To verify the individual's age when providing age-	
15		restricted goods or services to the individual if	
16		there is any reasonable doubt of the individual's	
17		having reached twenty-one years of age;	

1	<u>(3)</u>	To prevent fraud or other criminal activity if the
2		individual returns an item or requests a refund and
3		the business uses a fraud prevention service company
4		or system;
5	(4)	To establish or maintain a contract between the
6		business and the individual; provided that the
7		information collected by scanning the individual's
8		Hawaii certificate of identification or driver's
9		license for the establishment or maintenance of a
10	·	contract shall be limited to the individual's:
11		(A) Name;
12		(B) Address;
13		(C) Date of birth; and
14		(D) Driver's license number or certificate of
15		identification number;
16	<u>(5)</u>	To record, retain, or transmit information as required
17		by state or federal law; and
18	(6)	To transmit information to a consumer reporting
19		agency, financial institution, or debt collector for
20		the purpose of approving, processing, or collecting
21		negotiable instruments, electronic funds transfers, or
22		other methods of payments.

- 1 (b) No business shall retain any information obtained
- 2 pursuant to subsection (a), except as provided in subsections
- 3 (a)(4) through (6). No business shall store, sell, or
- 4 disseminate any information obtained under this section for any
- 5 purpose, including marketing, advertising, or promotional
- 6 activities.
- 7 (c) Any business, except a consumer reporting agency, debt
- 8 collector, or financial institution, that obtains information by
- 9 scanning the machine-readable zone of an individual's
- 10 certificate of identification or driver's license pursuant to
- 11 subsection (a), shall purge or delete any information so
- 12 obtained no later than five days after it is obtained.
- (d) A business subject to this section shall make
- 14 reasonable efforts, through systems testing and other means, to
- 15 ensure that the requirements of this chapter are met.
- (e) Any contract or agreement that purports to be a waiver
- 17 of any provision of this section is contrary to public policy
- 18 and is void and unenforceable.
- 19 (f) For purposes of this section:
- 20 "Consumer reporting agency" shall have the same meaning as
- 21 in the federal Fair Credit Reporting Act, title 15 United States
- 22 Code section 1681a(f).

- "Debt collector" shall have the same meaning as in the 1 2 federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, title 15 United 3 States Code section 1692a. "Financial institution" shall have the same meaning as in 4 5 the federal Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, title 15 United States Code 6 section 6809." 7 SECTION 2. Section 487J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 9 and to read as follows: 10 ""Scan" means to access the machine-readable zone of an 11 individual's Hawaii certificate of identification or driver's 12 license with an electronic device capable of deciphering, in an 13 electronically readable format, information electronically 14 encoded on an individual's Hawaii certificate of identification 15 or driver's license." 16 SECTION 3. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending its title to read as follows: 17 18 "CHAPTER 487J
- [SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER] PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION" 20 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 21 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 22 begun before its effective date.
