## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERSONAL INFORMATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to rea	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§487</u>	7J- Unlawful use of Hawaii identification card or
5	driver's	license. (a) No business may scan the machine-
6	readable z	zone of an individual's Hawaii identification card or
7	driver's	license to use or retain any information contained
8	therein, e	except for the following purposes:
9	(1)	To verify the age of the individual who possesses the
10		Hawaii identification card or driver's license;
11	(2)	To verify the authenticity of the Hawaii
12		identification card or driver's license;
13	(3)	To record, retain, or transmit information as required
14		by state or federal law; and
15	(4)	To transmit information to a consumer reporting
16		agency, financial institution, or debt collector, for
17		the purpose of approving, processing, or collecting

1	negotiable instruments, electronic funds transfers, or		
2	other methods of payments.		
3	(b) A business, other than a consumer reporting agency,		
4	financial institution, or debt collector, may not retain or use		
5	any information obtained by the scanning of the machine-readable		
6	zone of an individual's Hawaii identification card or driver's		
7	license other than as provided herein and may not sell or		
8	otherwise disseminate any information obtained under this		
9	section to a third party for any purpose, including any		
10	marketing, advertising, or promotional activities.		
11	(c) A business, other than a consumer reporting agency,		
12	financial institution, or debt collector, shall purge or delete		
13	any information obtained by scanning the machine-readable zone		
14	of an individual's Hawaii identification card or driver's		
15	license immediately or no later than five days after scanning is		
16	completed.		
17	(d) A business covered by this section shall make		
18	reasonable efforts to ensure that the requirements of this		
19	chapter are complied with through cooperation by systems testing		
20	and other means.		
21	(e) For purposes of this section:		

- 1 "Consumer reporting agency" shall have the same meaning as 2 in the federal Fair Credit Reporting Act, title 15 United States 3 Code section 1681a(f). "Debt collector" shall have the same meaning as in the 4 5 federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, title 15 United 6 States Code section 1692(a). 7 "Financial institution" shall have the same meaning as in 8 the federal Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, title 15 United States Code 9 section 6809." 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 487J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending its title to read as follows: 11 12 "[SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER] PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION"
- "[SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER] PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION"
- 13 SECTION 3. Section 487J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 15 and to read as follows:
- 16 ""Scan" means accessing the machine-readable zone of an
- 17 individual's Hawaii identification card or driver's license by
- 18 an electronic device capable of deciphering electronically
- 19 readable information on an individual's Hawaii identification
- 20 card or driver's license."
- 21 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
