## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANDFILLS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a host 1 2 municipality benefit fee to be paid by operators of privately 3 owned or operated recovery facility or landfills to offset the 4 impact of the facility. SECTION 2. Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 7 and to read as follows: 8 "§342G- Host municipality benefit fee. (a) Each 9 operator of a privately owned or operated resource recovery landfill, excluding transfer stations, shall pay a host 10 11 municipality benefit fee to the county in which the facility or 12 landfill is located. The fee shall be a tax of \$4 per ton of 13 solid waste processed at the facility. 14 (b) The host municipality benefit fee shall increase on January 1 of every year by at least cents, but by no more 15 16 cents. The fee shall be in lieu of all taxes, fees, than charges, or assessments imposed by the county in which the 17 18 facility or landfill is located, except for real estate taxes
