A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the artificial 2 sweetener aspartame has been the subject of several 3 controversies since the federal Food and Drug Administration 4 first approved it in 1981. The legislature also finds that 5 complaints of various health issues, including brain cancer and 6 birth defects, have been associated with consumption of high 7 levels of aspartame. The purpose of this Act is to require a product warning 8 9 label on all food products containing aspartame that are offered 10 for sale or distribution in the State. SECTION 2. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 12 13 and to read as follows: 14 Regulation of products containing aspartame. sale or distribution in the State of any product containing 15 16 aspartame is prohibited unless the product label contains the following statement: "This product contains aspartame, which 17 may cause brain cancer and birth defects in pregnant women."" 18



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1 SECTION 3. Section 328-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, i
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- 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 ""Aspartame" has the same meaning as in 21 Code of Federal
- 5 Regulations 172.804."
- 6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
