# A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

RELATING TO THE PENAL CODE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1.   Section 707-715, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3       **"§707-715   Terroristic threatening, defined.**   A person  
4 commits the offense of terroristic threatening if the person  
5 threatens, by word or conduct, to cause bodily injury to another  
6 person or serious damage or harm to property, including the pets  
7 or livestock, of another or to commit a felony:

8       (1)   With the intent to terrorize, or in reckless disregard  
9           of the risk of terrorizing, another person[+],  
10          including the pets or livestock of that person; or

11       (2)   With intent to cause, or in reckless disregard of the  
12          risk of causing evacuation of a building, place of  
13          assembly, or facility of public transportation."

14       SECTION 2.   Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken.   New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
