6	SECTION 3. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the
7	respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the
8	respectively identified cases, and in several amounts
9	hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,
10	upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided that the
11	departments shall obtain the approval of the attorney general
12	before payment of any claim can be made.
13	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
14	interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
15	shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
16	applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
17	as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
18	cases to which the statute applies.
19	SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
20	appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
21	June 30, 2013, shall lapse.
