## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that it is important to SECTION 1. 2 protect pet animals from cruel treatment and prevent pet animals 3 from unnecessary or prolonged suffering. Steel-jawed leg-hold 4 traps were originally designed to capture fur-bearing animals 5 such as bears, fox, beavers, and other animals that are not 6 present in Hawaii. Snares and foot- or leg-hold traps were 7 designed to capture other non-domesticated animals. 8 Unfortunately, domesticated pet animals are frequent 9 victims of snares and may also become victims of steel-jawed 10 leg-hold, conibear, or foot- or leg-hold traps. Cases have been 11 reported of dogs and cats found dead or severely injured after 12 being caught in these devices, or chewing off their own limbs in 13 an attempt to escape these devices. 14 The legislature further finds that existing laws and 15 administrative rules do not prohibit or regulate the use of 16 steel-jawed leq-hold, conibear, foot- or leq-hold traps or 17 snares, all of which can be easily purchased on the Internet.

20	and, upon	request, shall be turned over to the animal control

2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§71</u>	1- Cruelty to animals by trapping. (1) A person
5	commits t	he offense of cruelty to animals by trapping if the
6	person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly uses, sets, or	
7	maintains:	
8	<u>(a)</u>	A steel-jawed leg-hold trap; or
9	(b)	A snare, conibear, or foot- or leg-hold trap in an
10		area zoned as residential or any other area where such
11		trap is prohibited by law or rule, except under the
12		situations described in subsection (2).
13	(2)	Subsection (1)(b) shall not apply to:
14	<u>(a)</u>	Persons carrying out accepted practices for rodent
15		control that do not involve the devices listed in
16		subsection (1); and
17	<u>(b)</u>	Employees or authorized agents of state or federal
18		agencies who are carrying out activities required
19		under a management plan approved by state or federal
20		agencies if pursuant to a mandatory statutory duty for
21		the protection of species listed as threatened or
22		endangered species, and other wildlife species



1 protected by law; or for the protection of public 2 health, safety, or property. 3 (3) As used in this section: "Conibear trap" means a contrivance consisting of metal or 4 5 steel designed to kill by crushing the body or severing the 6 spinal cord of any animal. 7 "Foot- or leg-hold trap" means a contrivance consisting of 8 metal or steel that is off-set, padded, or laminated, and is 9 designed to capture and hold any animal by a foot or limb. 10 "Snare" means a contrivance consisting of a noose, 11 regardless of material, designed to capture, trap, or kill any 12 animal or hold any animal by a foot, limb, or neck. 13 "Steel-jawed leg-hold trap" means a spring-powered 14 contrivance that captures or holds the limb of an animal by 15 exerting a lateral force with fix-mounted jaws. 16 (4) Cruelty to animals by trapping is a misdemeanor." 17 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 18 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 19 begun before its effective date. 20 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Animal Cruelty; Trapping

## Description:

Requires dogs or cats that are captured or killed in a snare or trap to be reported to a county animal control officer. Establishes an animal cruelty offense for the use of steel-jawed leg-hold traps, and the use of snares, conibear, and foot- or leg-hold traps in residential or other prohibited areas; provides exemptions for activities carried out by state and federal agencies; establishes the offense as a misdemeanor.
