BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-106.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$286-106.5[+] Expiration of licenses; out-of-country
- 4 active duty military personnel[-] and dependents.
- 5 Notwithstanding section 286-106, the expired driver's license of
- 6 a member of any component of the United States armed forces who
- 7 is on active federal service, or the member's dependent if the
- 8 dependent accompanied the member, and whose driver's license
- 9 expired while the member was deployed outside the United States,
- 10 shall remain valid for ninety days after the service member's
- 11 return to the United States."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
