## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 481X, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

  amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and

  to read as follows:

  "PART . INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS

  \$481X- Definitions. As used in this part:

  "Internet protocol address" means a numerical label
- 7 assigned to each device participating in a computer network that
- 8 uses the internet protocol for communication and provides host
- ${f 9}$  or network interface identification and location addressing.
- 10 "Internet service provider" means a company that provides
  11 access to the Internet.
- 12 §481X- Recordkeeping requirements for internet service
- 13 providers. Any internet service provider that provides internet
- 14 service to a consumer in the State shall retain consumer records
- 15 for no less than two years. The required data for the consumer
- 16 records shall include each subscriber's information and internet
- 17 destination history information. Destination information shall
- 18 include any of the following:



- 1 (1) Internet protocol address;
- 2 (2) Domain name; or
- 3 (3) Host name."
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 481X, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by designating sections 481X-1 to 481X-12 as part I,
- 6 entitled "General Provisions".
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
