A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 171C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§17</u>	1C- School facilities special fund. (a) There is
5	establish	ed a school facilities special fund into which shall be
6	deposited	all proceeds from leases, permits, interest income
7	generated	from public school lands and facilities, and other
8	revenue g	enerated from the non-permanent disposition of public
9	school la	nds and facilities under this chapter, less the
10	following	<u>:</u>
11	(1)	The principal and interest on bonds issued pursuant to
12		this chapter for projects on public school lands or
13		utilizing public school facilities;
14	(2)	The cost of administering, operating, and maintaining
15		projects on public school lands or utilizing public
16		school facilities, not to exceed fifteen per cent of
17		the sums collected, net of principal and interest
18		payments on bonds; and

1	(3) Other sums that may be necessary for the issuance of		
2	bonds under this chapter.		
3	(b) The school facilities special fund shall be		
4	administered by the department of education in consultation with		
5	the board of education. Except as otherwise provided, all		
6	moneys in the school facilities special fund shall be used		
7	exclusively for the new construction and upgrade of twenty-first		
8	century school facilities, and the retrofit and upgrade of		
9	existing school facilities to meet twenty-first century school		
10	standards."		
11	SECTION 2. Section 171C-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
12	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
13	"(a) There is established the Hawaii public land		
14	development revolving fund, to which shall be credited any state		
15	appropriations to the fund, any sums collected as a result of		
16	bonds issued pursuant to this chapter, any revenues generated		
17	from the facilities, except as provided in section 171C- , or		
18	other moneys made available to the fund, to be expended as		
19	directed by the corporation."		
20	SECTION 3. The public land development corporation shall		
21	submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty days		
22	prior to the convening of the regular session of 2013 detailing		

- 1 the progress made with the school facilities special fund,
- 2 including sites being considered for non-permanent disposition
- 3 and the process the corporation is employing to select where the
- 4 construction of new facilities and retrofitting of existing
- 5 facilities for the twenty-first century will be done.
- 6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Public School Facilities; Public Land Development Corporation

Description:

Establishes the school facilities special fund. Requires that income generated by the Public Land Development Corporation from public school lands and facilities be deposited into the school facilities special fund for the purposes of new construction, upgrades, and retrofit and upgrade of public school facilities. Includes a reporting requirement. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB2534 HD1)
