BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: Bell schedules. The department shall devise up 4 5 to four standard bell schedules for each grade level. A school 6 shall have the discretion to implement one of the available bell 7 schedules for each grade level. This section shall not apply to 8 charter schools or multi-track public schools." 9 SECTION 2. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended as follows: 1. By amending subsections (d) and (e) to read: 11 "(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [for 12 **13** the 2016-2018 school years, beginning no later than the 2014-14 2015 school year, all public schools, excluding charter schools 15 and multi-track public schools, shall [implement a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional development 16 17 days and other non-instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty student 18

- 2 grades.] maintain standard instructional periods by implementing
- 3 a bell schedule devised by the department under section 302A-

- **19** and (d)."
